By following our Treasure Map, you will be led to a series of clues set up along a 1-mile path in a local park; once you solve the puzzles included with each clue, you'll be able to unlock a treasure chest full of small prizes to take home.

This hunt is ideal for younger buccaneers, ages 2-12, and their families.
